



Poppy

Socks



- Size:** Women
- Yarn:** Arwetta Classic or other similar yarn (210m/50gr), approx. 50 gr for a size 39
- Needle size:** 2.5 mm or 3 mm
- Gauge:** 30 sts/10cm

These socks are knitted toe- up with a German short row heel and finished with a rolling edge.

Toe:

Cast on 11 sts on each needle with Judy`s magic cast on, 22 sts total

Needle 1 is on the top of the foot. Needle 2 is the sole of the foot.

Knit one round.

Now you shall start increasing for the toe:

- Rnd 1: *KFB, k to 2sts remain on needle 1, KFB, k1* rpt *-* on needle 2
- Rnd 2: K.

Rpt knitting rnd 1 and rnd 2 until you have 29sts on each needle. 58sts total.

Finish with rnd 2

Foot:

K according to pattern on needle 1, and k stockinette st on needle 2 until you have reached your desired length. Check the size chart. Heel is approx. 5,5 cm.

Heel:

K the heel with the 29 sts on needle 2.

Start on the ws:

Turn, mds. P to the end. Turn.

Mds, k to ds. Turn, mds, p to ds. Turn

Rpt *-* until you have 9 sts left that are not ds.

*Mds. K to ds, k the ds. K the next ds. Turn

Mds, p to ds. P the ds, P the next ds. Turn*

Rpt *-* all sts

Tip: To avoid getting holes on the sides when you knit in the round again, you can pick up a stitch on each side that you knit together with the next stitch.

Leg:

Dec one st on each side of the leg so you have 27 sts on needle 2 and 29 sts on needle 1. Continue knitting accordingly to pattern on both needles. On needle 2 you eliminate the first and last purl stitches. Knit according to pattern for 14 rnds.

K 12 rnds, bind off loosely with Jeny`s surprisingly stretchy bind off.

By doing this you get a rolling edge.

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

Mds = Make double stitch

P = Purl

Ds = Double stitch

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Dec = Decrease

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Rpt = Repeat

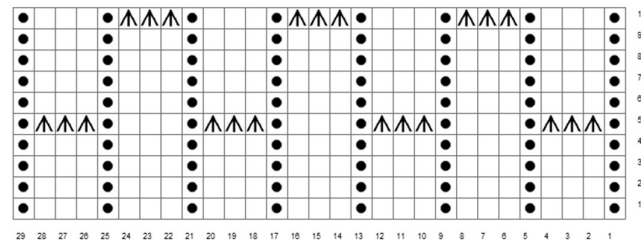
Kfb = Knit through the front and the back loop (1st increased)

Pattern:

□ Knit

● Purl

▲▲▲▲ Poppy



You knit a Poppy like this: K three stitches together without slipping them off the left needle, yarn over, k the three same stitches together again. By doing this, you will end up having three new stitches.
