



Haustratt

Socks



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- Size:** Women
- Yarn:** HS Soft Sock or other similar yarn (425m/100gr) Approx 50 gr in size 39
+ a small scrap for the lace edge
- Needle size:** 2.5 mm or 3 mm
- Gauge:** 30 sts/10cm
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Haustratt means autumn night in Norwegian. These socks are knitted toe-up, with a *German short row heel* and finished with a rolling edge and an optional lace edge.

Toe:

Cast on 11 sts on each needle with *Judy's magic cast on*, 22 sts total

Needle 1 is on the top of the foot. Needle 2 is the sole of the foot.

Knit one round.

Now you shall start increasing for the toe:

- Rnd 1: *KFB, k to 2sts remain on needle 1, KFB, k1* rpt *-* on needle 2.
- Rnd 2: K.

Rpt knitting rnd 1 and rnd 2 until you have 29sts on each needle. 58sts total. Finish with rnd 2.

Foot:

K according to pattern on needle 1, and k stockinette st on needle 2 until you have reached your desired length. Check the size chart. Heel is approx 5,5cm

Heel:

K the heel with the 29 sts on needle 2.

Start on the ws:

Turn, mds. P to the end. Turn.

Mds, k to ds. Turn, mds, p to ds. Turn
Rpt *-* until you have 9 sts left that are not ds.

*Mds. K to ds, k the ds. K the next ds. Turn.
Mds, p to ds. P the ds, P the next ds. Turn.*
Rpt *-* all sts .

Tip: To avoid getting holes on the sides when you knit in the round again, you can pick up a stitch on each side that you knit together with the next stitch.

Leg:

Dec one st on each side of the leg so you have 27 sts on needle 2 and 29 sts on needle 1. Continue knitting accordingly to pattern on both needles. On needle 2 you eliminate the first and last purl stitches. Knit according to pattern for 14 rnds.

K 12 rnds, bind off loosely with *Jeny's surprisingly stretchy bind off*

By doing this you get a rolling edge.

Lace edge:

Pick up 57 sts on the inside of the sock where you started with the stockinette st.

- Rnd. 1 *P 1, k 2* Rpt *-* to the end of the rnd
- Rnd. 2 *P 1, k 1, 1 yo, k 1* Rpt *-* to the end of the rnd
- Rnd. 3 *P 1, k 3* Rpt *-* to the end of the rnd
- Rnd. 4 *P 1, k 1, 1 yo, k 1, 1 yo, k 1* Rpt *-* to the end of the rnd
- Rnd. 5 *P 1, k 5* Rpt *-* to the end of the rnd

Cast off.

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

Mds = Make double stitch

P = Purl

Ds = Double stitch

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Dec = Decrease

St(s) = Stitch(es)

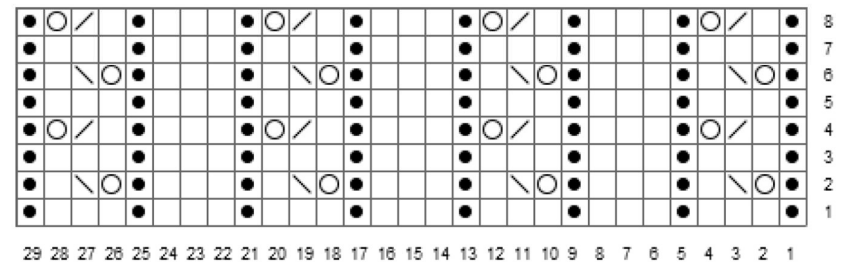
Yo = Yarn over

Rpt = Repeat

Kfb = Knit through the front and the back loop (1 st increased)

Pattern:

- ☐ = KNIT
- ◻ = SSK
- ◻ = K2TOG
- = YO
- = PURL
